Robin Dacuycuy reads minutes from previous meeting. Don't have quorum to approve.

Tonilee Castillo reads financial report.

Terry Daun asks about new FFCA lot. Mikale informs FFCA new lot is on Leila, survey has been done, and permits have been put in.

Terry Daun brings to Mac Castillo's attention to not do anything on CDHFF Lot without President approval. Mac had moved some gravel on request from Evan Belaga. Mac confirmed he would not do any work there anymore. Further more the arrangement between Mac Castillo and CDHFF were independent, personal agreements that had nothing to with FFCA.

MikaleHudson informs James Miles that his election to the Board will have to be at the next meeting, due lack of quorum.

Mikale Hudson lets CDHFF members know that the FFCA board has discussed and voted on CDHFF lot and FFCA will not be getting involved with CDHFF lot at this time.

Road Report:

Roads that have been worked on in February are:

Alli Kane, Omao, Upper Kaleponi, and Upper Kokokahi to Noe Kuahiwi(upper middle) road.

Mac reports that tractor was down for 2 weeks during February.

Mac has talked to owner of container on Jungle King and she will be unloading it. Mac confirms that is the last thing that needs to be moved to start on Jungle King project.

Hannah Hedrick would like to know if FFCA has anything in writing for Road Maintenance Schedule. Board confirms that Road maintenance schedule as approved in January is in effect through 2012. See January 3rd, 2012 minutes.

Board confirms that recycled cement is holding up well and the only issue we have with it is the dust.

Public Comments:

Kathy Frontino brought sample of nails found on road after recycled cement was dumped and spread. Mikale explains we cannot control what will be in loads and it's possible that we get some bad loads occasionally, but over all we have been happy with the material we receive. He thanked her for bringing it to meeting and Mikale will take it to Glover and let them know what we have found in the crushed cement.

Terry Daun mentions some of his plants where killed from spraying on Captain's Drive. Mac confirms that he only sprayed easement. Terry would not confirm if it was in easement. Mac will go look at it and see if it is. And apologizes to Terry. Mac confirms that if it is on easement it will be sprayed.

Hannah Hedrick (see Attached) brought a letter she would like us to review. Mikale reviewed and lets her know that it does not concern FFCA and FFCA will not be discussing it at FFCA meetings. Reconfirms that The FFCA does not want to get involved with CDHFF issues or Lot.

Sharon Daun presented a flyer for Community Action Training.

Mac Castillo confirms we will be doing road work on bottom half of forest in March.

Caroline Frazier brought good comments from Fern Forest residents on the good job FFCA and Mac Castillo are doing on the roads.
