10:26: Mike Muench read the financial report- We have collected \$231,000. As of the end of Feb. We finished our 2017 Sweep and will assess the roads and start our 2018 sweep. We are putting down an experimental mixed chip on Kaleponi and will monitor it and how well it holds up. We'll continue to fill pot holes in March. Imi motioned to accept the treasury report-Board accepted unanimously.

10:42: Kathy Frontino read the note from the Feb. 10<sup>th</sup> 2018 meeting. Imi motioned to accept the minutes-Board accepted unanimously. Imi reiterated about the new chip mix on Kaleponi and when it dries up some will put more gravel on the pot holes. Imi thanked Bill Watkins for volunteering his time as a road coordinator. He is solely on a volunteer basis, no money is involved or paid out and we appreciate having him help in this matter.

Imi is looking into buying all new DOT standard, reflexive street signs, starting on the 2 main-paved roads, Ala Kapena (Captains Dr.) and Kahau lea. Looking at costs from the mainland. Hannah Hedrick will look into the funding from the county specifically for the Upper Puna Emergency Response & Preparedness funds.

New Business: Imi Brought up some issues about frustrated people calling office phone and yelling and cussing at our secretary. This will not be tolerated.

Rhonda Lickfelt spoke briefly and thanked various people for the help she received after her husband's death.
